SUBJECT: SEPA LEAD AGENCY & DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

Sylvan Pearl Timber Sale #103620 and Forest Practice Application #2423677 proposal considered more than 334 acres for harvest and was reduced to 164 net acres consisting of seven variable retention harvest units, and one right of way unit, removing approximately 6,251 MBF of merchantable timber. The proposal includes 66,495 feet of required pre-haul maintenance, 4,464 feet of optional construction, 5,130 feet of optional pre-haul maintenance, and 3,358 feet of abandonment, if constructed. Located in Sections 25, 36, Township 21 North, Range 08 East, and Sections 19, 20, 29, 30, Township 21 North, Range 09 East, W.M., King County.
