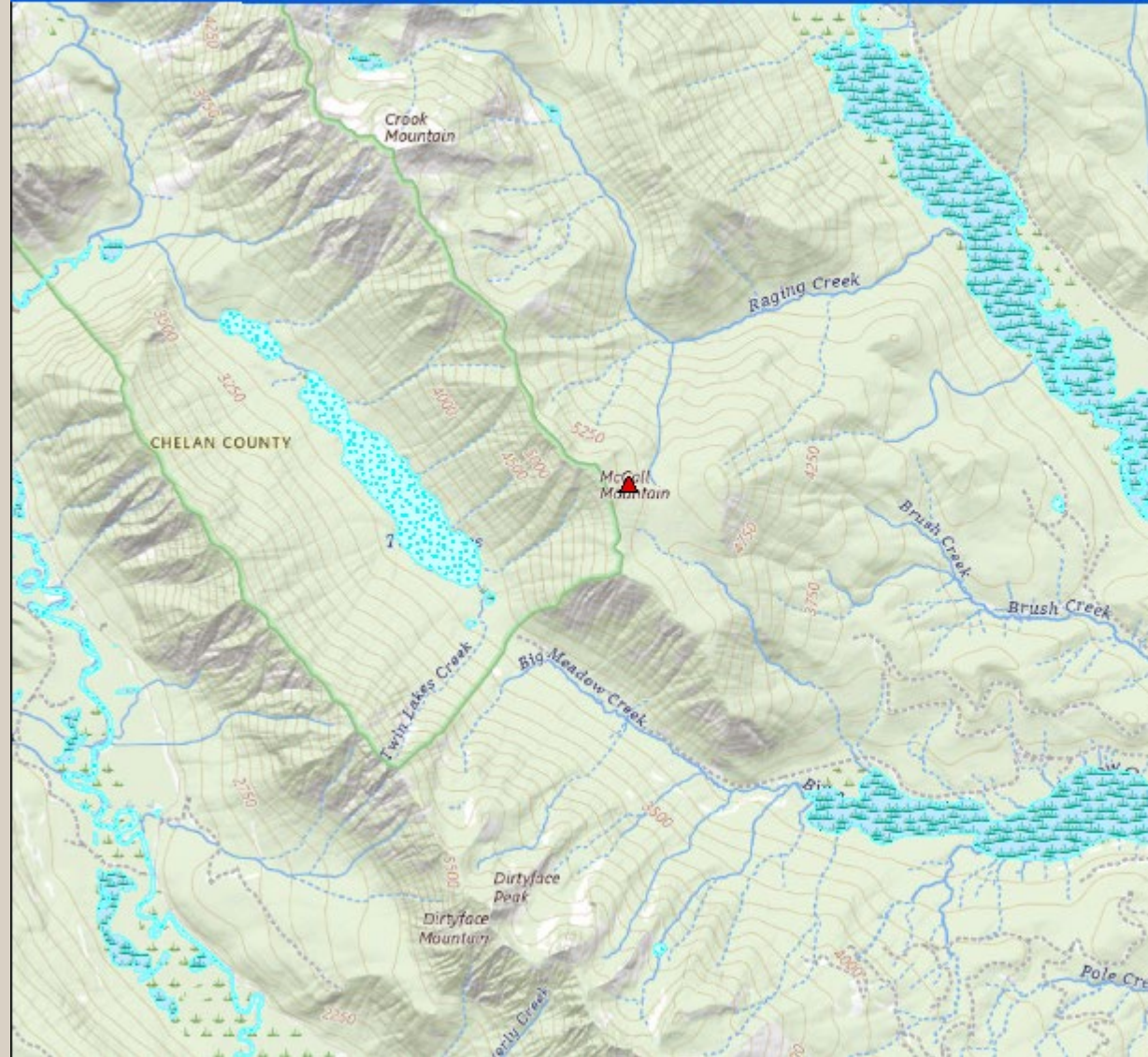

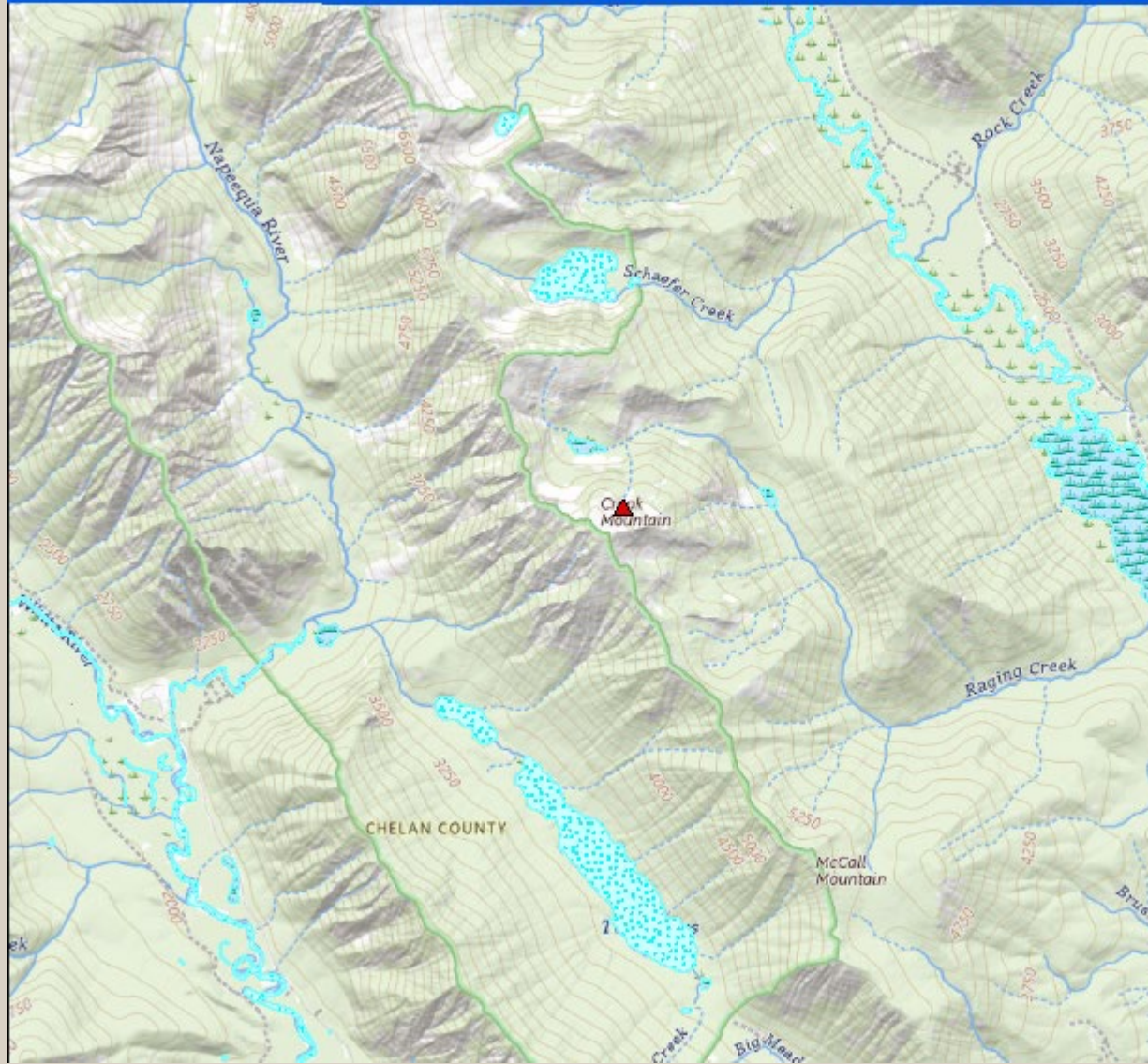
Huckleberry Mountain - CHELAN COUNTY



Rename mountain north of Lake Wenatchee. Currently named McCall Mountain after General James McCall, famous for an 1858 massacre. Proposed name is to return to the English translation of the indigenous name of Huckleberry Mountain. Sacred Mountain was the placeholder proposal of the original proponent until consultation with the Colville Confederated Tribes occurred.



Goat Mountain - CHELAN COUNTY



Rename mountain northwest of Lake Wenatchee. Currently named Crok Mountain after General George Crook, famous for an 1858 massacre. Proposed name is to return to the English translation of the indigenous name of Goat Mountain. Spirit Mountain was the placeholder proposal of the original proponent until consultation with the Colville Confederated Tribes occurred.



Schoolhouse Creek - KLINKITAT COUNTY



Unnamed stream: Flows roughly west into White Salmon River near Husum.
Proposed name is for the former schoolhouse forty in the vicinity. The proponent hopes this to be the first step in the forestland eventually becoming Schoolhouse Natural Area to be used for educational purposes.
