- Each permittee must possess a valid permit when harvesting, processing or transporting the special forest products covered by the permit.
- 2 This permit is valid **only** for the product and dates indicated on the permit.
- The products may be removed **only** in the location indicated on the permit and attached map(s). Permittee is responsible for determining harvest area boundaries and legal access to harvest area.
- The colored vehicle placard must be displayed visibly in windshield of vehicle during harvest and/or transporting of any special forest products.
- All harvest debris must be removed from roads and ditches and scattered throughout the forest. All garbage generated by permittee must be removed from state land.
- Permittee will do all in their power to prevent forest fires. No fires are allowed outside designated campgrounds.
- No camping is allowed outside designated campgrounds. Approved campsites have a seven (7) day stay limit. Some DNR campgrounds may be closed during the winter.
- This permits does not guarantee the quality or quantity of product purchased.
- Permittee will harvest products using acceptable harvest practices. Rakes and any ground disturbing devises are not allowed. Permittee will not harvest in a manner that causes undo damage to the resource and/or associated ecological values. If damage occurs, the state may access penalties. No harvest of any material within 50 feet of any flowing stream, dry stream bed, body of standing water or within 200 feet of a DNR-designated campground.
- Law enforcement action will be taken for unauthorized harvest, trespass or littering.
- This permit is non-refundable and is revocable for failure to comply with permit terms and conditions.
- No motorized vehicles allowed off existing road surfaces. Use of ATV's or motorcycles will be permitted for <u>permit holder only</u> on forest roads (no off-road use). Permit must be with you at all times.
- All vehicles engaged in any harvest operations are required to have minimum vehicle liability insurance.
