

Northwest Region Permit Valid: Until December 20th, 2024 **Firewood Cutting Permit** Permit Name: Flywheel

A Discover Pass is required to access DNR recreation lands. For information on how to purchase the pass, visit www.discoverpass.wa.gov or call 1-866-320-9933. Find out where you'll need a Discover Pass on DNR-managed state trust lands at www.dnr.wa.gov/recreation.

Permit must be in vehicle window and available upon request

Do not cut any standing trees, snags, or blow-down timber.

Only cut blowdown that has crossed roads. Permitted areas are highlighted in yellow on map. No cutting is allowed in wooded areas along roadways.

Firewood is for personal use only **Do Not Block Roads**

- 1) Limit of 6 cords per family with this permit.
- 2) Cut only wood that is dead and on the ground.
- 3) Cedar is not authorized for removal.
- 4) Firewood cutting will be allowed during the closed season if the following conditions are met:
 - No cutting is allowed on fire precaution level 2 or above. Call 1-800-323-2876 for this information.
 - All fire tool requirements must be met for power saws, including approved spark arresters, fire extinguishers, and shovel.
 - Smoking is not allowed in unit on a level 2 or above day, except in vehicles.

Obey all signs posted in the unit

- 5) Do not disturb <u>ANY</u> planted seedlings if present.
- 6) Motorized equipment and/or vehicles must stay on roads (do not drive on skid trails).

7) No removal or cutting of firewood is allowed more than 50 feet from the edge of truck road running surfaces.

8) Keep road surface and ditches clean.

9) Roads on attached maps may be abandoned at any time.

Any false statement made in this application or violation of these terms

is punishable as a Gross Misdemeanor.

This permit may be voided by any State DNR Forester on demand.






DRIVING DIRECTIONS:

From the junction of SR-542 and Mosquito Lake Rd, travel 0.9 miles. Turn left on North Fork Rd (which becomes the NF-ML at the end of the paved county road). Travel 4.2 miles, cross the bridge over Racehorse Creek and continue 1.3 miles on the NF-ML. Turn right onto the SM-ML and travel 0.6 miles. Turn right on the RH-ML and travel 4.8 miles. Continue straight on the RH-50 spur for 0.6 miles to access Unit 1A.
