


PERMIT CONDITIONS A. THIS PERMIT AUTHORIZES THE REMOVAL OF FIREWOOD FROM SPECIFIED DNR LANDS SUBJECT TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THIS PERMIT. B. FIREWOOD MAY ONLY BE REMOVED FROM THE APPROVED UNIT(S) AS SHOWN ON THE ATTACHED MAP(S). C. ALL FIREWOOD MUST BE DOWN AND DEAD; REMOVAL OF STANDING TIMBER IS PROHIBITED. D. ALL FIREWOOD MUST BE LOCATED WITHIN \_\_\_\_\_\_ FEET OF AN ACTIVE ROAD OR LANDING. E. FIREWOOD CUTTING IS PROHIBITED WITHIN RIPARIAN MANAGEMENT ZONES. F. FIREWOOD CUTTING IS PROHIBITED WITHIN LEAVE TREE CLUMPS AND OTHER AREAS AS POSTED. TREES MARKED WITH PAINT SHALL BE LEFT IN PLACE AND MAY NOT BE CUT OR MOVED. G. All vehicles must stay on existing roads and/or landings. H. Vehicle use is prohibited in areas that have been abandoned or closed. Use of ATV's, ORV's, and/or motorized equipment (excluding power saws), is prohibited within the firewood unit. Mechanical yarding is prohibited on DNR land. K. The firewood unit may be closed, suspended, or terminated at any time as deemed necessary by DNR. L. Firewood is available on a first come, first serve basis only; DNR cannot guarantee the quantity/quality of firewood available. M. Firewood is intended for personal use only; the permit and/or firewood may not be traded or sold. N. This permit is valid for one household only and is non-transferable; each household may remove a maximum of six (6) cords of wood each calendar year from DNR land (RCW 79.15.420) regardless of how many permits are obtained. O. This permit is valid only for the person and vehicle listed on the permit. P. Smoking in logged areas is illegal and may cause a serious fire. O. THIS FIREWOOD UNIT CLOSES ON . No firewood shall be removed after this date. R. Firewood units will be open \_\_\_\_\_ days a week unless otherwise posted. S. Firewood units will be "open" daily from \_\_\_\_ to \_\_\_\_ unless otherwise posed. 



Directions from Hoodsport to Unit 1: Travel north on US 101 for 10.3 miles. Turn left onto USFS 24 Road (Jorstad Creek Road) and travel 5.8 miles to the intersection with the 2420 road. Firewood Unit N Continue 0.5 miles on USFS 24 Road from 2420 Road to gate on 2000 Road. Turn left and go through gate on 2000 Road. Travel 1.0 mile on 2000 Road. Driving Route Turn right on the 2020 Road travel for about 500 feet to the 2021 road then travel for 150 feet to Unit 1. Other Road Directions from Hoodsport to Units 3, 6, 7: To Unit 3: Drive north on SR-119 for 8.6 miles. Turn east on 1240 Road and go through the blue gate and drive 1.5 miles. Turn left on 1200 Road at "Y" intersection and drive 1.9 miles past the Highway Saddle Rock Pit. Continue on the 1200 road for 0.26 miles to Unit 3. Milepost Markers To Unit 7: continue on the 1200 road for 0.4 miles to unit 7. To Unit 6: Continue on the 1200 for 500 feet and turn left onto the 1270 road travel for 0.6 miles to Unit 6. 





## FIREWOODPERMIT MAP
