DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: The installation of a fish passable 23'- 5"x 9'- 3" x 71'- 3" (W x H x L) arch and approximately 250 feet of associated road reconstruction is planned for this location. Construction will entail clearing and grubbing to excavate to the arch concrete footing depth, steel arch assembly, backfill and compaction of fill, stream channel reconstruction and armoring of adjacent fill slopes.

Proponent: Department of Natural Resources

Location of proposal, including street address, if any: Section 16, all in Township 07 North, Range 04 East, W.M., approximately 32 miles by road, northeast of Woodland WA in Cowlitz County.

Lead agency: Department of Natural Resources
