REQUIREMENTS & CONDITIONS

- LIMIT 6 CORDS ANNUALLY
- * First Come, First Serve Basis.
- * For personal use only.
- * NO RESALE.
- NO CEDAR MAY BE CUT OR REMOVED.
- Vehicles must stay on the Roads – DO NOT block roads.
- Keep all ditches, roads & landing free of debris.
- Be careful of newly planted seedlings.
- No cutting live trees, standing snags, or blue painted trees.
- Mechanical yarding NOT permitted.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS FOR FIRE SEASON

(April 15 to October 15)

Power saw operators must have a:

- Shovel and fire extinguisher on-site AND an approved spark arrester on ALL chain saws.
- Cutting allowed on PRECAUTION LEVEL 1 days only.
- Fire extinguisher must be minimum $2 \frac{1}{2}$ pounds.
- A fire watch is required for one hour following shut-down of chain saws.
- Call 1-800-527-3305 or for fire Season information.





From Exit 49 off I-5, follow SR 504 east for 10.4 mi. Turn right onto South Toutle Rd and follow for 2.6 mi. to the 4100. Continue on the 4100 for 2.3 miles to the 4200 Junction.

Unit 1: Turn onto the 4200 from the 4100. Follow for 5.2 miles and turn onto the 4250. Follow for 3.7 miles. The unit will be on the right.

Unit 2: From Unit 1 continue on the 4250 for 0.5 miles and turn right onto the 5100. After 1.8 miles the unit will be on the right.

Unit 3: Turn onto the 5100 from the 4250.

Units 4-8 and 5110 ROW: From Unit 3 Continue on the 5100 for 1.3 miles to the 5110 Intersection. All units will be on the right side of the 5110 reconstruction.

5100 Pit. From the 4100/5100 Junction follow the 5100 for 6.8 miles. The pit will be on the left

Malarkey Units. Continue on the 5100 from the 5100 pit for 3 miles.
