Sales Offered

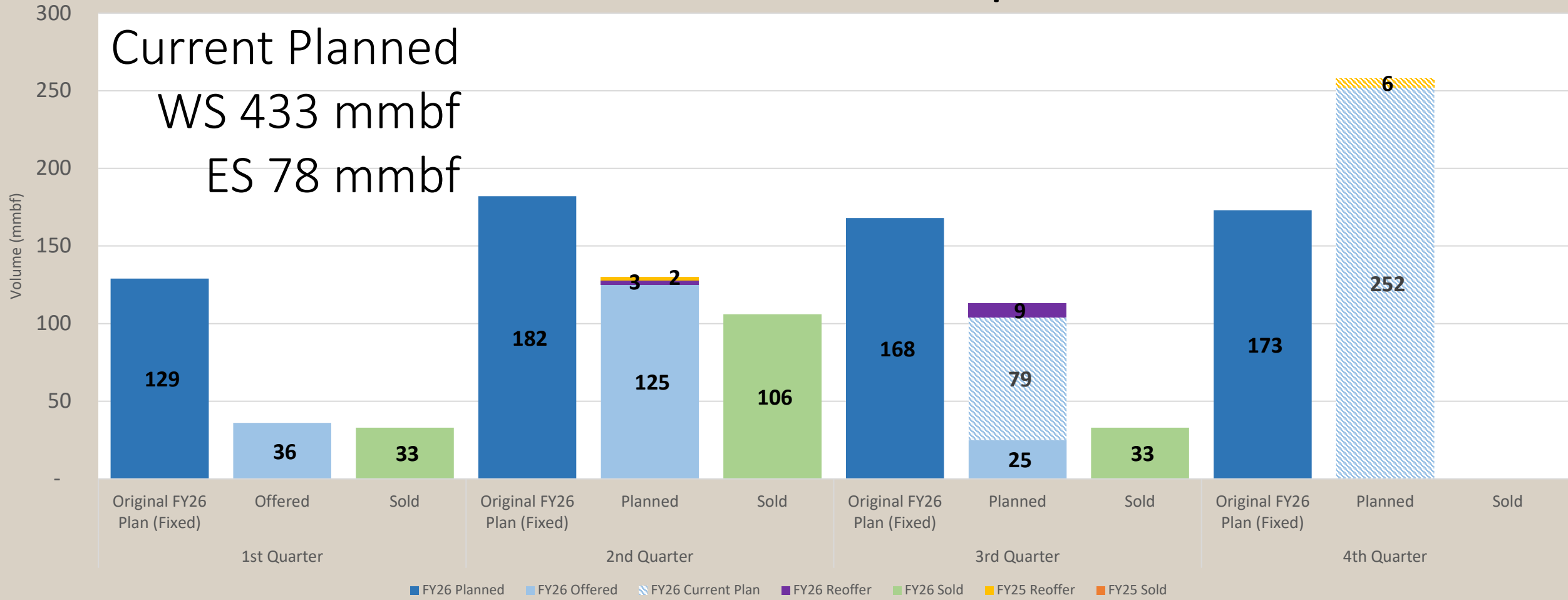
- 11 sales

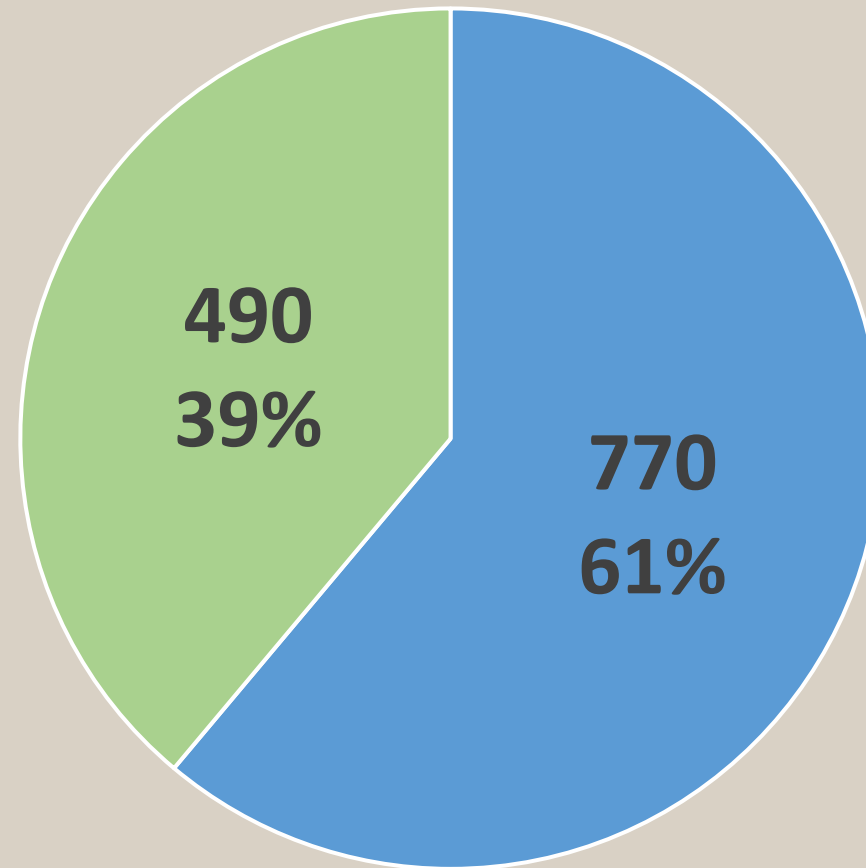

Westside Sale Proposal Acreages

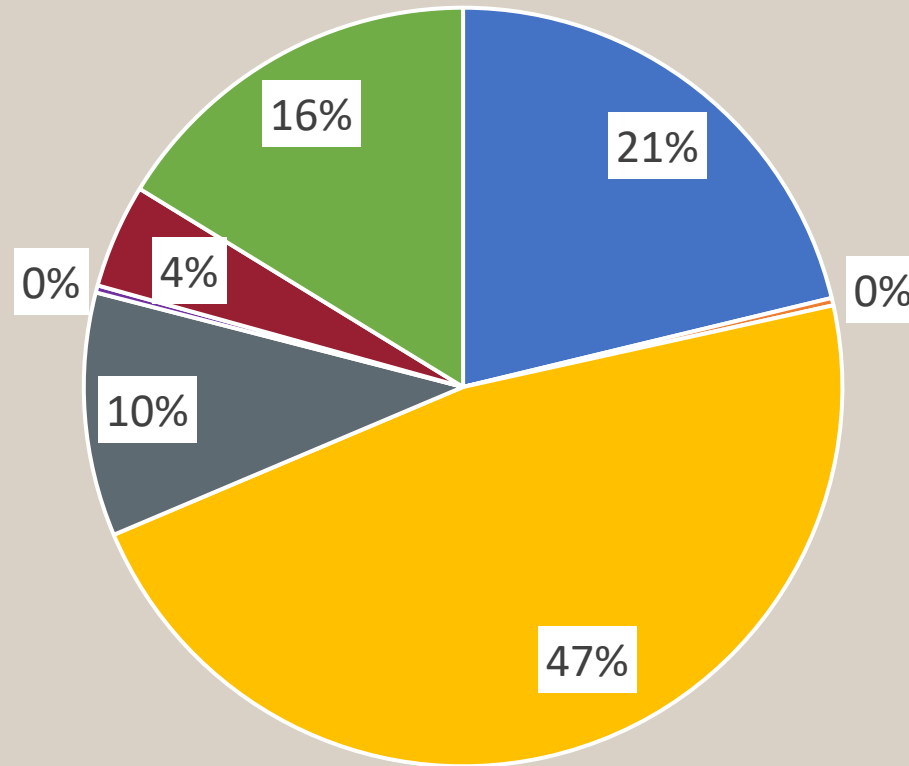

Q Bighorn Sorts

History of the site & why action is needed:

- Fire regime & forest condition
 - Reduction in naturally occurring wildfires and lack of management has led to conifer encroachment
- Poor site class and feasibility
- Neighbor constraints



Q Bighorn Sorts

What's Needed to Create Bighorn Sheep Habitat:

- Habitat needs
 - Reducing forested habitat while increasing horizontal visibility
- Silvicultural Prescription
- Wildland Urban Interface & forest health
- Alternate FPA



Q Bighorn Sorts

Role of the Wild Sheep Foundation & Future Opportunities:

- Wild Sheep Foundation
 - \$500k supporting Bighorn Sorts habitat enhancement efforts
- Importance to the Colville Tribes
 - In 2023 CTCR 38 bighorn, well below population objectives
